David P. Street Dissertation Prize in Engaged Sociology 2016

The Department of Sociology at the University of Illinois at Chicago is pleased to announce its call for nominations for the David P. Street Dissertation Prize in Engaged Sociology. This award is intended to recognize excellence in dissertation research in the Department. In keeping with the spirit and wishes of the family of David P. Street, a former Head of the Department and an outstanding sociologist, this award is intended specifically to honor an outstanding dissertation completed within the past two calendar years (2015 or 2016) that deals directly with issues of *engaged sociology*. The Award carries a monetary prize of \$500.00.

Submission deadline: April 4, 2016

Instructions for Submission:

1. All graduate students who received their doctoral degree in 2015 or 2016 are eligible for this Award.
2. Letters of nominations must be submitted by the dissertation chair.
3. Students must submit a five-page summary of the dissertation. The summary must provide a concise description of the content of the work along with an explanation for the ways in which the work represents engaged sociology.
