The *Department of Sociology Graduate Student Teaching Award* recognizes a graduate student who has achieved excellence in teaching in the field of Sociology. To be eligible students must be in the process of meeting requirements for a doctoral degree in Sociology and be in good standing in the program. This award recognizes the following qualities in graduate student teaching:

- Creation or use of ground-breaking teaching methods and/or course materials.
- Superior job teaching and engaging students in the classroom while honing their skills to become the next generation of college and university faculty.

***Nomination deadline: March 18, 2020***

**Instructions for Nomination & Submission:**

1. Graduate students may be nominated, through a letter of nomination, by either a faculty member in the Department of Sociology or a student at the University of Illinois at Chicago. Nominations must be addressed to the Awards Committee and submitted by **March 18, 2020**, to the Sociology Department by emailing [socstudentworker@gmail.com](mailto:socstudentworker@gmail.com).
2. Graduate students who have been nominated will be notified immediately. Upon nomination graduate students must prepare a teaching portfolio. The portfolio must include at minimum a teaching statement, syllabi, supporting course materials, and course evaluations (including a report from a faculty observation) as well as any other relevant materials.
3. All completed supporting materials must be received as one PDF file no later than **April 8, 2020**, to [socstudentworker@gmail.com](mailto:socstudentworker@gmail.com)
4. Winner must attend the Annual Sociology Awards Celebration on Wednesday, April 24, 2019, in BSB 4105 at 12:00 pm in the Sociology Department.
